Amelia Capone serves as the Director of Parking and Curbside Management for the City of Boston, where she leads the modernization of the city's parking and curb ecosystems to align operations with broader transportation and sustainability goals. With a deep background in organizational strategy and strategic procurement, Amelia recently directed the overhaul of Boston's 40-year-old parking services contract, replacing legacy systems to enhance compliance, efficiency, and customer experience.

Prior to her role with the City of Boston, Amelia was a Government Innovations Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School's Government Performance Lab. There, she led multi-year initiatives to redesign contracting systems and improve vendor diversity and economic

mobility. Her career also includes managing a \$120M+ grant portfolio at the Rainforest Alliance and serving as a Community Health Facilitator with the Peace Corps in Peru, where she used diagnostic studies to drive community-led solutions.

Amelia holds an A.B. in Social Anthropology and Archaeology with a secondary degree in Global Health and Health Policy from Harvard University. She leverages this multidisciplinary lens to transform rigid infrastructure, prioritizing cross-departmental collaboration and human-centered design to drive measurable innovation in government performance.
